Common problems. Use a general-purpose, balanced fertiliser and avoid excessive feeding. Water trees regularly during dry spells and mulch to retain moisture in the soil. Summer pruning of apple trees reduces the leaf area. However, avoid heavy pruning.

An apple tree grown from a seed typically takes six to 10 years to yield fruits. Apple saplings sold at plant nurseries are typically cultivars grafted onto rootstocks. A rootstock determines tree size and how long it takes the scion cultivar growing on it to produce apples.
