He continued to experiment with colour in his still-lifes, which included the yellow 'Still-Life with Fruit' and the ambitious Romans parisiens.

He wanted a gallery to display his work and started a series of paintings that eventually included Van Gogh's Chair (1888), Bedroom in Arles (1888), The Night Caf  (1888), Caf  Terrace at Night (September 1888), Starry Night Over the Rhone (1888), and Still Life: Vase with Twelve Sunflowers (1888), all intended for the decoration for the Yellow House.
